

# Weinstein Stage Analysis

## Stage 2 Identification Criteria — The Only Stage Worth Buying

All 4 criteria must pass for Stage 2 classification. Missing one = likely Stage 1 or transition.

#	CRITERIA	PASS ✓
01	<b>Price above the 200-day Moving Average (30-week MA)</b> Price must be above the 200 DMA. This is the single most important Stage 2 condition. <i>NSE: Weekly chart equivalent is 30-week MA. Kasauti uses 200 DMA on daily chart.</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
02	<b>Price above the 150-day Moving Average</b> Price above 150 DMA confirms the intermediate uptrend is intact alongside the long-term trend. <i>NSE: This filter removes stocks that are above 200 DMA but struggling with 150 DMA resistance.</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
03	<b>50-day MA is above the 200-day MA (MA crossover)</b> The 50 DMA must be above the 200 DMA — the classic golden cross configuration. <i>NSE: The 50/200 crossover on weekly charts often precedes the largest NSE bull runs.</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
04	<b>200-day MA is trending upward (rising slope)</b> The 200 DMA must have a rising slope. A flat or declining 200 DMA = Stage 3 or Stage 1. <i>NSE: Many NSE stocks appear above their 200 DMA but with a flat/declining MA — these are Stage 3.</i>	<input type="checkbox"/>
